It's easy to participate

1. Decide the amount of your monthly offering (Decide what you want to give each year and divide that amount by twelve. Or decide on your weekly offering amount and multiply that by 4.33, as there are 4.33 weeks in a month).
2. Complete the Electronic Fund Transfer Authorization form in this pamphlet, provide account information as indicated or attach a cheque marked "VOID"
3. Allocate your regular monthly offering in the space provided.
4. Email the completed pamphlet to raeparke@hotmail.com and kristine.coffin@sympatico.ca or place it in the collection plate.

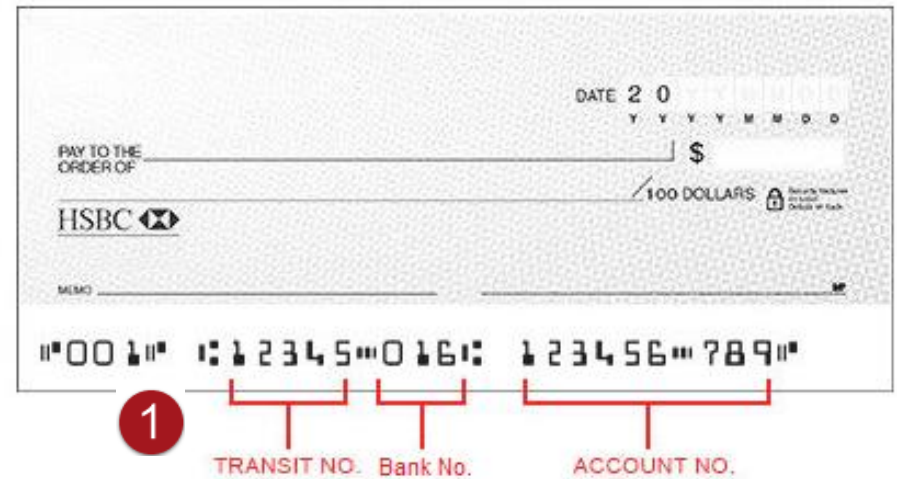

How to Find your Banking Information for Electronic Fund Transfer Authorization Form

In order to sign up for pre-authorized contributions, the Transit Number, Bank Number and Account number you will use to withdraw the money from is required for form submission. Please see below for the following ways you can obtain this information, so you can submit your form via email, as well as not have to use a cheque or go to the bank to obtain the information. - 1 Review your personal cheque and type the corresponding numbers in the fields in the form, from the information provided on your cheque



- 2 Log into your online banking account and locate your account information and type the corresponding numbers in the fields in the form, from the information provided on your cheque
